– the practice of gaining a feeling of superiority over another person.



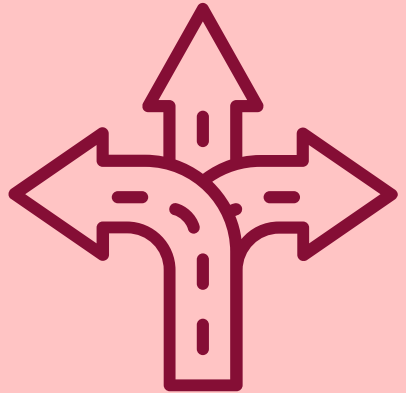
ONCE BITTEN, TWICE SHY
