10 IDIOMS ABOUT FRIENDSHIP

1. A SHOULDER TO CRY ON

- Someone to listen understandingly

- Staying connected and very close, especially with family

4. THROUGH THICK AND THIN

- To be there through any circumstances

5. AS THICK AND THIEVES

- To be very close and friendly

- To be in agreement or to have the same perspective about something

7. TO BUILD BRIDGES

- It means creating and promoting friendly relations between groups and communities

8. TO GET ON LIKE A HOUSE ON FIRE

- To be in a very well relationship or friendship with someone

9. TO HIT IT OFF

- It means getting into a good and friendly relationship with someone, in a very casual and natural

- To be familiar with someone; to know someone very well
