



# THE QUARREL OF THE MONKEY AND THE CRAB

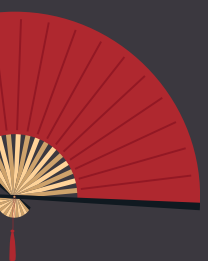
## GREED
