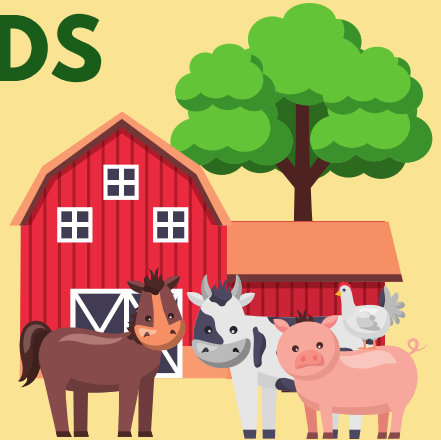

LET SLEEPING DOGS LIE

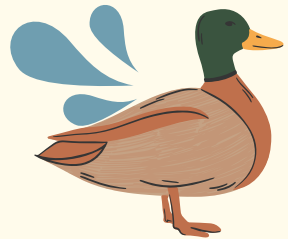
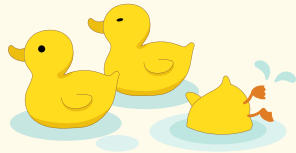
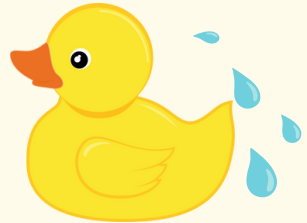
- to avoid interfering in a situation that is currently causing no problems

– to hear the information from someone who has personal knowledge on the spoken matter



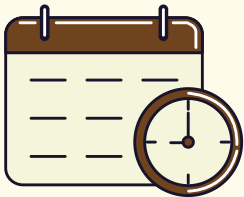
DON'T COUNT YOUR CHICKENS BEFORE THEY HATCHED

- to not make plans that depend on something good happening before you know that it has actually happened



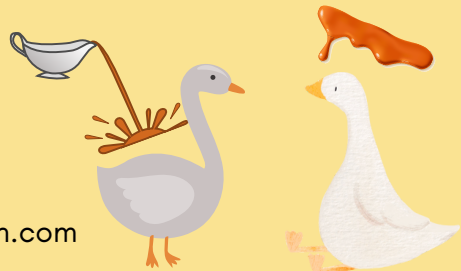
DONKEY'S YEARS
